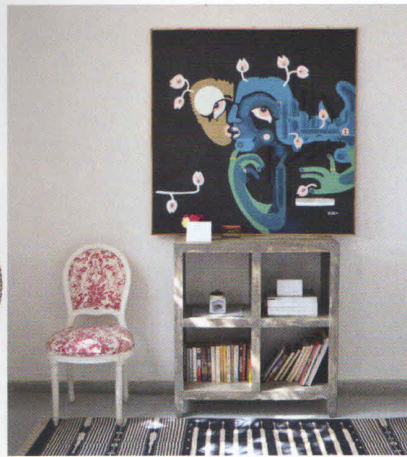
It has been a season of store openings. Here are the newest ones that are worth a visit



ROCHE BOBOIS

MUMBAI

Spread across 5,000 square feet, this French furniture brand's showroom in Lower Parel will retail its newest collections—Les Contemporains and Nouveaux Classiques—and iconic products such as the bohemian 'Mah Jong' sofa. We recommend this store for its accessories, lighting products and contemporary furniture designs.

It also showcases a collection of photographs, ceramics, artworks and music albums and occasionally hosts exhibitions and workshops.

GURGAON

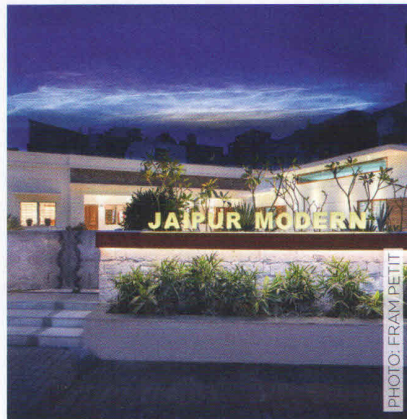
This sprawling 20,000-square-foot store in Gurgaon is a venture by KAFF and its Italian associates. It boasts of a comprehensive collection of wardrobes, sofas, lounge chairs, dining tables, beds, TV consoles and more. These pieces are primarily crafted using leather and fabric.



KAVITA SINGH INTERIORS

MUMBAI

This new Bandra store is a start-up by mother-daughter duo Kavita and Nandini Singh. While the furniture has been designed by Kavita who is also an interior designer, the other items in the store—art from pichwais to Kalighat paintings, objets d'art in silver and bronze, accessories and a unique collection of chandeliers and lights—have been sourced by both.



JAIPUR MODERN

JAIPUR

Located in a 1920s bungalow in the heart of Jaipur, this store retails art, apparel, furniture, furnishings, textiles and home linen, and also has an Italian café. Architect Rooshad Shroff spruced up the old structure and designed the interiors in a mix of stone and brick. The highlight, however, is the hand-embroidered wall.
